

NMNA Minutes
October 13, 2014
Hilltop Park

Meeting was called to order by President, Sharon Dwight at 7:00 PM. Board members present were Sharon, Carole, Nancy, Bob, Howard, and Brendan. Absent was Paula Cathey.

GUEST SPEAKER: Rich Deal, City Traffic Engineer reported on three upcoming projects:

- 1) The proposed roundabout at the junction of Highway 1 and Highway 68. A roundabout was selected over upgrading the existing traffic signal controlled intersection. Construction is slated to begin in September 2015 and end around Thanksgiving of 2016.
- 2) Parking study results. The study of 2011 has been found to be accurate and good for the present.
- 3) 230 Lighthouse. All construction traffic will go down Lighthouse. Oversized trucks need permits and will only be allowed at night.

Minutes from Sept. 98, 2014 were approved as read.

SHARON REPORTED:

The bus for the AMAP Salinas Art Deco Tour will leave the Del Monte Shopping Center promptly at 9:30 Saturday, Oct. 25 and will return at 2:30.

Monterey City Manager reported on the State of the City. His report focused on the conference center, restructuring the information management system, problems of the homeless for which private security has been hired for downtown, balancing the needs of tourists and residents. He also spoke on Measure P. If passed, it will raise eight million dollars a year to repair handicapped ramps. It will also repair some streets...not necessarily the streets that are in the worst condition, those that are at 25 points or less. The police department is understaffed with nine officers out and seven vacancies.

LIGHTHOUSE SPECIFIC PLAN: Next meetings will be October 23 at 7:00 pm Hilltop Park and Oct 24, Friday morning, at Scholze Park. Land use is scheduled to be discussed.

TREASURERS REPORT: Approved as read.
